## Senior News

### Penalty for Violation by Graduating Students

- a. Graduating students who violate Board policies on possession, consumption, or distribution of alcoholic beverages, controlled dangerous substances, counterfeit controlled dangerous substances, noncontrolled substances as defined by Article 27, Section 286B of the Annotated Code of Maryland, or other intoxicant at any time during the last four weeks of school prior to the last scheduled day for graduating students, or during the time between the last scheduled day and the graduation ceremony, whether the activity takes place on school buses, within a school building or upon any school property, or during any school, school related, or Board sponsored activity, whether held on school property or at locations off school property, including private clubs, businesses, or commercial establishments, shall be prohibited from participation in all senior activities, including proms, award ceremonies, and graduation ceremonies.
- b. Diplomas earned by students denied participation in graduation ceremonies will be available upon request in the office of the appropriate school principal on the first workday following graduation ceremonies.

## \*\*\*\*\*PROM\*\*\*\*\*

The Senior Prom will be held at M & T Bank Stadium on Saturday, May 21, 2016 from 7:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. You will not be permitted to enter before 7:00 p.m. The dress for the prom is formal: girls should wear a gown and boys should wear a tux and dress shoes. If you are not dressed appropriately, you will not be admitted. No refunds will be given.

- ⇒ Ticket information will be provided to the senior class once available.
- ⇒ You must have your ticket. You will not be admitted without a ticket, and no tickets will be sold at the door.
- ⇒ All students and guests must abide by the AACPS Student Code of Conduct.
- ⇒ Alcoholic beverages and other drugs are strictly prohibited. Students found with these items, or students who arrive after having ingested these items, will not be permitted entrance or will be required to leave the prom, will be subject to police action as well as administrative action, and will not be permitted to participate in graduation exercises.
- ⇒ If a senior date does not attend Chesapeake High School, the student must have the GUEST PERMISSION FORM approved for both Prom and the After Prom Party to purchase tickets.
- ⇒ Formal Attire is required. Admission will be denied if apparel is not formal.... No jeans, flip-flops, tennis shoes or t-shirts allowed. Ladies formalwear with cut outs should not expose areas that may be deemed inappropriate. No plunging necklines, or abdominal cut outs. **Remember**, this is a school function. Please see Mr. Dennis if you have any questions.
- ⇒ Once students leave the prom, they will not be permitted to return.
- ⇒ Photographers from Lifetouch will be available at the prom to take pictures. All pictures must be pre-paid on the night of the prom.
- ⇒ After Prom Party is a FREE event for all Chesapeake High School Seniors. There will be two separate tickets, one for PROM and one for AFTER PROM PARTY. Seniors not attending prom MAY still attend the After Prom Party but they must register and pickup a FREE ticket during prom ticket sales at CHS.

NO TICKETS WILL BE ISSUED AT THE DOOR.

**Outside guests may only attend the After Prom Party if they attended the Prom  
and a guest permission slip is on file**

The same rules that apply for dances apply for this event.

**All seniors must be in good standing with class dues and school obligations to participate in the Senior Prom and receive guest tickets for Graduation. Please see Ms. Figueroa /Mrs. Beyer for information.**

- ◆ Rehearsal—May 25th & 26th 10:30 am—2:00 pm (Please meet in the main gymnasium)  
**\*\*\*\*You must attend rehearsal to participate in the graduation ceremony/students must be in good standing with class dues and obligations to participate in the graduation ceremony \*\*\*\***
- ◆ Tickets and Cap & Gowns will be distributed after rehearsal  
**Caps & Gowns may not be recycled from previous years**  
**If you have not ordered your cap and gown, please see Ms. Figueroa/Mrs. Beyer promptly.**
- ◆ Graduation Ceremony—Thursday, June 2nd @ 10:00 am  
**\*\*Graduates should arrive by 8:30 am \*\* and report to the main gymnasium**
- ⇒ Required attire is as follows: All—Professional, no flip-flops, tennis shoes or shorts;  
**Girls**—appropriate and light colored clothing so nothing shows through, spiked heels are not allowed due to turf.  
**Guys**—dress shirt and tie w/slacks and dress shoes. Students dropped off should report directly to the Gym. Students who drive must park at Downs Park and will be shuttled by bus to CHS.
- ⇒ Prepare your gown according to the instructions provided so that you can look your best. (Note: Ironing is not recommended, instead hang the gown in a steamy bathroom, or if you do press your gown, place a towel between the hot iron and the fabric.)
- ⇒ As each graduate receives his/her diploma, a professional photographer from Lifetouch will take picture. Seniors are under no obligation to purchase these pictures. You will receive information on prices and packages for these pictures and the proof following graduation.
- ⇒ Students must retain their **cap** in order to receive their actual diploma after the ceremony.
- ⇒ Graduation Day is a significant and special day for seniors and their families. Any inappropriate behavior before or during graduation ceremonies will not be tolerated and may result in a student's exclusion from graduation ceremonies. This includes behavior at all rehearsals.
- ⇒ All members of the audience including parents, family, and other friends are guests of Chesapeake High School. Consequently, they must adhere to all ceremony rules. Any member of the audience who uses a noise making device, such as an air-horn, will promptly be removed.

Due to Fire Marshal restrictions the number of tickets available for each graduate is limited. The number of available tickets are colored coded and convert to designated areas in the event of rain.

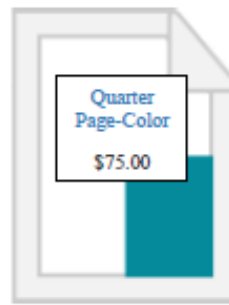
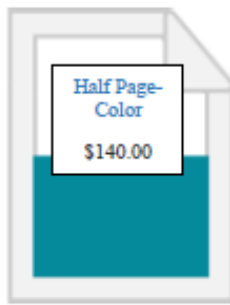
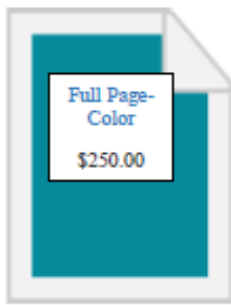
