Penalty for Violation by Graduating Students

- a. Graduating students who violate Board policies on possession, consumption, or distribution of alcoholic beverages, controlled dangerous substances, counterfeit controlled dangerous substances, noncontrolled substances as defined by Article 27, Section 286B of the Annotated Code of Maryland, or other intoxicant at any time during the last four weeks of school prior to the last scheduled day for graduating students, or during the time between the last scheduled day and the graduation ceremony, whether the activity takes place on school buses, within a school building or upon any school property, or during any school, school related, or Board sponsored activity, whether held on school property or at locations off school property, including private clubs, businesses, or commercial establishments, shall be prohibited from participation in all senior activities, including proms, award ceremonies, and graduation ceremonies.
- b. Diplomas earned by students denied participation in graduation ceremonies will be available upon request in the office of the appropriate school principal on the first workday following graduation ceremonies.

The Senior Prom will be held at Martins West on Saturday, May 20, 2017 from 7:30 p.m. until 11:30 p.m. You will not be permitted to enter before 7:30 p.m. The dress for the prom is formal: girls should wear a gown and boys should wear a tux and dress shoes. If you are not dressed appropriately, you will not be admitted. No refunds will be given.

- ⇒ Ticket information will be provided to the senior class once available.
- ⇒ You must have your ticket. You will not be admitted without a ticket, and no tickets will be sold at the door.
- ⇒ All students and guests must abide by the AACPS Student Code of Conduct.
- ⇒ Alcoholic beverages and other drugs are strictly prohibited. Students found with these items, or students who arrive after having ingested these items, will not be permitted entrance or will be required to leave the prom, will be subject to police action as well as administrative action, and will not be permitted to participate in graduation exercises.
- ⇒ If a senior date does not attend Chesapeake High School, the student must have the GUEST PERMISSION FORM approved for both Prom and the After Prom Party to purchase tickets.
- ⇒ Formal Attire is required. Admission will be denied if apparel is not formal.... No jeans, flip-flops, tennis shoes or t-shirts allowed. Ladies formalwear with cut outs should not expose areas that may be deemed inappropriate. No plunging necklines, or abdominal cut outs. **Remember**, this is a school function. Please see Mr. Dennis if you have any questions.
- ⇒ Once students leave the prom, they will not be permitted to return.
- ⇒ Photographers from Lifetouch will be available at the prom to take pictures. All pictures must be prepaid on the night of the prom.
- ⇒ After Prom Party is a FREE event for all Chesapeake High School Seniors. There will be two separate tickets, one for PROM and one for AFTER PROM PARTY. Seniors not attending prom MAY still attend the After Prom Party but they must register and pickup a FREE ticket during prom ticket sales at CHS.

NO TICKETS WILL BE ISSUED AT THE DOOR.

**Outside guests may only attend the After Prom Party if they attended the Prom
and a guest permission slip is on file**

The same rules that apply for dances apply for this event.

- ↑ 1. Head west on MD-177 W/Mountain Rd toward Dock Rd
7 min (3.6 mi)

Follow MD-100 W, I-97 N and I-695 W to Security Blvd in Woodlawn. Take exit 17 from I-695 W
24 min (22.2 mi)

- ↩ 2. Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto MD-100 W
4.2 mi
- ↩ 3. Keep left at the fork to stay on MD-100 W, follow signs for MD-97
3.8 mi
- ↪ 4. Use the right 2 lanes to take exit 13B to merge onto I-97 N toward Baltimore
3.3 mi
- ↩ 5. Keep right at the fork to stay on I-97 N, follow signs for I-695 W/Baltimore/Towson
0.8 mi
- ↩ 6. Merge onto I-695 W
9.5 mi
- ↪ 7. Take exit 17 for Security Blvd toward Woodlawn
0.3 mi
- ↩ 8. Keep left at the fork and merge onto Security Blvd
0.3 mi

Take Belmont Ave to Dogwood Rd in Milford Mill
3 min (1.2 mi)

- ↩ 9. Merge onto Security Blvd
0.3 mi
- ↪ 10. Turn right onto Belmont Ave
0.8 mi
- ↩ 11. Turn left onto Dogwood Rd

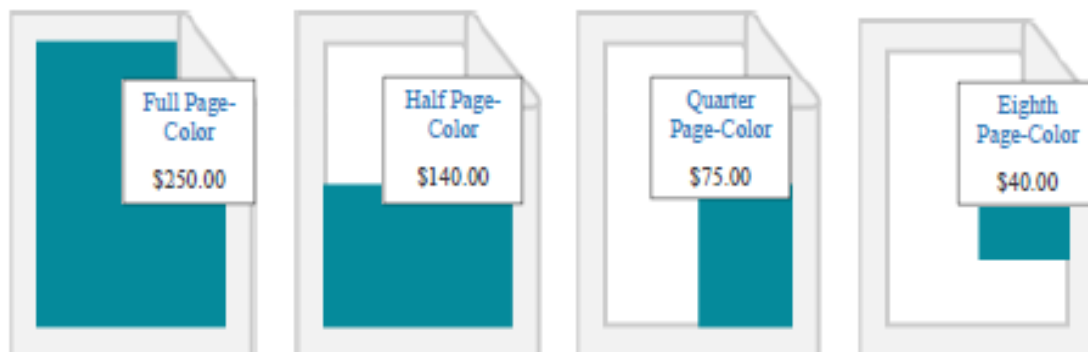
