Penalty for Violation by Graduating Students

- a. Graduating students who violate Board policies on possession, consumption, or distribution of alcoholic beverages, controlled dangerous substances, counterfeit controlled dangerous substances, noncontrolled substances as defined by Article 27, Section 286B of the Annotated Code of Maryland, or other intoxicant at any time during the last four weeks of school prior to the last scheduled day for graduating students, or during the time between the last scheduled day and the graduation ceremony, whether the activity takes place on school buses, within a school building or upon any school property, or during any school, school related, or Board sponsored activity, whether held on school property or at locations off school property, including private clubs, businesses, or commercial establishments, shall be prohibited from participation in all senior activities, including proms, award ceremonies, and graduation ceremonies.
- b. Diplomas earned by students denied participation in graduation ceremonies will be available upon request in the office of the appropriate school principal on the first workday following graduation ceremonies.

C. The date for last 4 weeks policy is **April 26th**.

Information about Student Recognitions and Graduation Speakers

As we prepare for graduation for the Class of 2018 on Wednesday, May 30th at 10 a.m., I want you to be aware of changes regarding student recognitions and which students address the class during the graduation ceremony. Last year, AACPS adopted a Latin Honors System in order to recognize the academic achievement of our outstanding seniors at commencement. This new tradition will continue again this year and for years to come. As with past graduations, the Senior Class President will bring welcome remarks and introduce our distinguished guests as well as give the farewell address to the class. Beginning this year, for the second student speaker, each high school principal will provide notice to all summa cum laude seniors that they have an opportunity to apply to be the graduation student speaker. The student speaker will be selected by a school-based committee from a pool of applicants that have earned the Summa Cum Laude Honor. The selection will occur no later than April 15th, and the school-based decision will be final. Please encourage your seniors to embrace this change in tradition. Note: Our Valedictorian and Salutatorian will still sit on stage to be honored and their name and achievement designation will be announced during their diploma presentation but will no longer have a speaking role during the ceremony unless they are selected as the second student speaker.

Applications will be distributed March 26th and will be due April 6th. Again, the final decision will be made by April 15th.

The Senior Prom will be held at Martins East on Saturday, May 5 2018 from 7:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. You will not be permitted to enter before 7:00 p.m. Doors will close at 8:30; anyone arriving after 8:30 will not be permitted to enter. The dress for the prom is formal: gown or tux and dress shoes. If you are not dressed appropriately, you will not be admitted. No refunds will be given.

- ⇒ Ticket information will be provided to the senior class once available.
- ⇒ You must have your ticket. You will not be admitted without a ticket, and no tickets will be sold at the door.
- ⇒ All students and guests must abide by the AACPS Student Code of Conduct.
- ⇒ Alcoholic beverages and other drugs are strictly prohibited. Students found with these items, or students who arrive after having ingested these items, will not be permitted entrance or will be required to leave the prom, will be subject to police action as well as administrative action, and will not be permitted to participate in graduation exercises.
- ⇒ If a senior date does not attend Chesapeake High School, the student must have the GUEST PERMISSION FORM approved for both Prom and the After Prom Party to purchase tickets. This form must be signed by administration BEFORE tickets can be purchased.
- ⇒ Formal Attire is required. Admission will be denied if apparel is not formal.... No jeans, flip-flops, tennis shoes or t-shirts allowed. **Remember, this is a school function.** Please see Mr. Watson if you have any questions.
- ⇒ Once students leave the prom, they will **not** be permitted to return.
- ⇒ Photographers from Lifetouch will be available at the prom to take pictures.
- ⇒ After-Prom Party is a FREE event for all Chesapeake High School Seniors who attended Prom. It will be run from 12:00-3:00 at Chesapeake (**Doors close at 12:30, after which no entry will be permitted**). Your Prom ticket will come with two tear-offs; one side will be torn off at Prom, the other side will be torn off at After-Prom. Do NOT lose your ticket at Prom. **You will NOT be admitted to After-Prom without your ticket.** NO TICKETS WILL BE ISSUED AT THE DOOR. No backpacks are allowed.
- ⇒ Volunteers are needed to make After-Prom a success. We are looking for people to help decorate the night of May 4th anytime between 2:30 and 10:30pm. On May 5th, we are looking for as many volunteers as we can get! The hours are 11:30 to 3:30 to accommodate set-up and clean-up.
- ⇒ We would also welcome any water bottle donations. They can be dropped off at the main office any time during school hours.

and a guest permission slip is on file**

1. Start out going west on Mountain Rd/MD-177 toward Varnedoe Ln.
----- Then 3.05 miles ----- 3.05 total miles
2. Take MD-100 W.
MD-100 W is just past Schmidts Ln.
----- Then 4.28 miles ----- 7.33 total miles
3. Take MD-10 N toward Baltimore.
----- Then 5.60 miles ----- 12.93 total miles
4. Merge onto I-695 E toward Dundalk/Essex (Portions toll).
----- Then 17.07 miles ----- 30.00 total miles
5. Merge onto Pulaski Hwy/US-40 E via EXIT 35B toward Aberdeen.
----- Then 1.81 miles ----- 31.81 total miles
6. Make a U-turn onto Pulaski Hwy/US-40 W.
If you are on Pulaski Hwy and reach Middle River Rd you've gone about 0.7 miles too far.
----- Then 0.24 miles ----- 32.05 total miles
7. Martin's East, 9000 PULASKI HWY is on the left.
